

DOWNSTATE ILLINOIS LABORERS' DISTRICT COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

AWARDS

Scholarships will be awarded up to \$1500. The available scholarships may be used for tuition, books, room and board and/or other related expenses.

ELIGIBILITY

- The scholarships are available to college students whose parents, legal guardians or who themselves are a member in good standing of the Downstate Illinois Laborers' District Council.
- Applicants must be enrolled Full Time in a University, College, or Vocational School and provide proof of enrollment.
- High School graduating applicants must provide transcripts for the past 4 years. College students must maintain at least a 2.6 cumulative or a 2.6 previous semester grade point average for the 2023-2024 school year and provide transcripts for the previous year.

*Recipients of the scholarship must be present at the District Council meeting to receive the award. Recipients must also volunteer at least 1 day each year and/or participate in fundraising efforts or other Union business required by the Business Manager.

AWARD BASED ON:

High School/College Transcripts Proof of Admission Financial Need Essay*

All information must be submitted to Downstate Illinois Laborers' District Council by July 1, 2024 in order to be eligible for the Scholarship.

Applications will be reviewed by the Downstate Illinois Laborers' District Council Scholarship Fund Trustees.
